



## “Social Distance Ready” COVID-19 Operational Protocols

Coronavirus (COVID-19) is impacting all of us. For the health and safety of all, we are implementing special practices for the duration of the outbreak.

These measures align with the [Center for Disease Control and Prevention’s \(CDC\) “social distancing”](#) and sanitation practices, and have been reviewed and approved by a physician at the [Infectious Diseases Society of America](#). These measures will allow us to continue operations while doing our part to contain the threat.

### What We are Doing

- We encourage golfers to pay in advance online or over the phone with a credit card, show up to a pre-positioned sanitized cart, and proceed to the first tee without personal contact.
- We are encouraging customers to update credit card information on file and book tee times or food and beverages service DIRECTLY with the club via PHONE during the social distancing period.
- Sit-down food and beverage services are unavailable at this time. Please call ahead, whenever possible to place your order so that waiting time and personal interaction is minimized. Limited seating for those awaiting “to go” orders ONLY.
- Gatherings should not exceed 9 people and persons and you MUST be able to maintain a 6-foot distance between others at ALL times.
- ALL water fountains and vending machines are shut down. Players are advised to purchase beverages prior to tee off.
- Course Restrooms will remain CLOSED for the duration until the order is lifted by the governor.
- We have increased frequency of routine cleaning(using approved antimicrobial products), sanitizing and disinfection of all locations, especially common and high traffic areas and frequently touched surfaces.
- Staff will be wearing protective gloves during all cash and credit card transactions.

- Rental carts will be properly sanitized prior to use.
- All ball washing stations have been removed, along with All rakes from sand traps and you should temporarily play these as a non-hazard.
- Player are directed to leave the pin in the cup at all times. Pool noodles have been placed in the cups raising the level of the ball to above the hole so that it may be removed without touching any surfaces. This is a good time for "gimmies."
- Scorecards and pencils will only be available upon request.
- Power carts will be SINGLE RIDER, except for those living in the same household.
- Golfers should go directly to their carts and park them in the return lane at the end of their round. Garbage should be placed in the receptacles provided.

**What should YOU do:**

- Please, stay at home if you are sick!
- Open doors with a paper towel or clean tissue, or push a door open with your back side.
- Do not congregate in rooms, but instead spread out in open spaces outside. (no less than 6 feet apart)
- Wash your hands often and thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer.
- AVOID touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- COVER your cough or sneeze with an elbow or tissue and then discard the tissue and wash your hands.
- AVOID groups of 10 or more.
- Replace handshakes with touchless forms of greeting.
