



Coronavirus (COVID-19) is impacting all of us. For the health and safety of all, we are implementing special practices for the duration of the outbreak.

These measures align with the [CDC](#) sanitation practices. These measures will allow us to continue operations while doing our part to contain the threat.

### What We are Doing

- We encourage golfers to pay in advance online, show up to a pre-positioned sanitized cart.
- We are encouraging customers to book tee times or food and beverages service DIRECTLY with the club via PHONE during the social distancing period.
- Please call ahead, whenever possible to place your order so that waiting time and personal interaction is minimized.
- Remember to Use Social Distancing when around others.
- ALL water fountains are shut down.
- Course Restrooms will remain CLOSED for the duration until the order is lifted by the governor.
- We have increased frequency of routine cleaning, sanitizing and disinfection of all locations, especially common and high traffic areas, and frequently touched surfaces.

### Golf Course

- Rental carts will be properly sanitized prior to use.
- FLAGSTICKS should not be removed. Cups are filled to allow ball retrieval without contacting the flag or cup.
- All ball washing stations have been removed, along with All rakes from sand traps and you should temporarily play these as a non-hazard.
- Player are directed to leave the pin in the cup at all times. PVC pipe has been placed in the cups raising the level of the ball to above the hole so that it may be removed without touching any surfaces.
- Power carts will be TWO per Cart. Single Rider Carts Available Upon Request for an additional Single Rider fee.

### What should YOU do:

- ✓ Please, stay at home if you are sick!
- ✓ Open doors with a paper towel or clean tissue, or push a door open with your back side.
- ✓ Do not congregate in rooms, but instead spread out in open spaces outside. (no < 6 feet apart)
- ✓ Wash your hands often and thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer.
- ✓ COVER your cough or sneeze with an elbow or tissue and then discard the tissue and wash your hands.
